RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. QUALIFICATIONS / CATEGORIES

The purpose of this contest is to promote public understanding of all livestock and their benefits to the world. All types of large and small livestock are eligible to be subjects of an educational display, even if there is no department for them at the fair. Livestock includes, but is not limited to, alpacas, cavies, cattle, goats, horses, llamas, poultry (all kinds), rabbits, sheep, and swine.

Display content may include (but is not limited to) livestock breeds, feeding, diseases, breeding, genetics, flock or herd management, pasture rotation, ecological benefits, fleeces, hides, fur, fitting and showing, hooves, horns, cuts for butchering, products made from livestock, etc.

The contest is open to anyone, whether exhibiting other animals at the fair or not. The contest is open to amateurs only. Professionals whose business is providing displays, exhibits, or advertising are not eligible.

There are three divisions:

Div. 1 - One person 19 years old or under (as of first day of the fair)

Div. 2 - One person 20 years old and up (as of first day of the fair)

Div. 3 - Teams of 2 or more people, any age

LIVE ANIMALS MAY NOT BE PART OF THE DISPLAY.

Entrants may use pictures, scale models, handwritten or computer text, graphs, diagrams, charts, illustrations, etc., but all work must be that of the individual entering.

Displays which have been used before (such as for Science Fairs, 4-H or FFA contests) are eligible, but evidence of previous awards must be removed. However, items previously entered in the Yavapai County Fair are not eligible.

2. ENTRY FORM(S) / FEES

Use the General Entry Form on page 7. All properly filled out entry forms / fees need to be submitted by Monday, Sept. 27, 2010 to Karen Clymer, Dept. LE Superintendent, c/o Yavapai County Fair, P.O. Box 26557, Prescott Valley, AZ 86312. ENTRY FEE IS \$2.00. Late entries need to be approved by the Superintendent -- please contact ASAP.

3. ENTRY DATES & PROCEDURES

Exhibits will be received at the Coors Event Center on Wed., September 29 between 5:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m. and also on Thursday between 8:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. Each exhibitor will be entitled to ONE fair entry pass regardless of how many entries the person has.

4. DISPLAY RULES

The minimum size of the display is 18" by 24". The maximum size is 3 feet by 4 feet. Three dimensional objects may be used (such as scale models, or actual equipment) but

must not project more than 6" beyond surface of the display.

Displays will be hung on a wall or arranged on a table by the Superintendent, so please make your entry easily displayable. The Fair Association or the Superintendent of this department will not be responsible for loss or damage to exhibits.

5. JUDGING & PREMIUMS / VOUCHERS

Entries judged on: educational Impact, workmanship, creativity

Awards:

Awards given in each division: 1st: \$10.00, 2nd: \$7.50, 3rd: \$5.00, 4th: \$2.50, "Best in Show": \$15.00, Superintendent Award: Rosette, People's Choice Award: Rosette.

ALL VOUCHERS MUST BE PICKED UP BY NO LATER THAN 3:00 P.M. AND CASHED BY 5:30 P.M. ON SUNDAY OCTOBER 3, 2010.

6. RELEASE DATES

Exhibits released Sun., Oct. 3, 2010 between 4:30 p.m. and 5:30 p.m. Exhibits not picked up will be discarded.
