### RULES AND REGULATIONS

#### 1. QUALIFICATIONS / CATEGORIES

Entries in the Junior Livestock are limited to boys and girls of Yavapai County who are 19 years or younger as of the first day of the fair. All exhibitors who reach age 14 before the opening day of the fair are Senior Youths, under 14 before opening day are Junior Youths, ages 5 to 8 by date of show are Peewees.

This department is strictly showmanship of small stock which includes rabbits, covies, pigeons, and all species of the poultry family. In order for a youth to participate in Showmanship he or she must enter the youth divisions of Department R for rabbits and covies and Department P for poultry and pigeons. 4-H membership is not required.

#### 2. ENTRY FORM(S) / FEES

All entries legibly written on Small Livestock Entry Form (AVAILABLE ONLINE AT [www.YavapaiDownsAtPV.com](http://www.YavapaiDownsAtPV.com)) all information completed. State your age on the entry blank. NO ENTRY FEE. Please send your completed entry form and fee by **MONDAY, SEPT. 27, 2010** to K.C. Brown, Dept. LS Superintendent, c/o Yavapai County Fair, P.O. BOX 26557, Prescott Valley, AZ 86312. If you must turn in your form before the show you can, but this causes delays.

#### 3. ENTRY DATES & PROCEDURES

Entrants are checked in on Thursday, September 30, 2010, between 2:00 and 2:30 p.m. (show starts at 3:00 p.m.) Each exhibitor will be entitled to ONE fair entry pass regardless of how many entries the person has.

#### 4. DISPLAY RULES

The YCFA assumes no responsibility for loss of or damage. Any animal, which shows signs of illness after the start of the fair, will be isolated and/or asked to leave.

All exhibitors should be neatly and appropriately attired: For safety reasons, it is strongly recommended that all small stock showmen wear long sleeved shirts preferably white, dark pants and closed toe shoes. No rings or nail polish on hands and dangling earrings will be allowed.

#### ROUND ROBIN

Round Robin Showmanship is a class reserved for all the Junior and Senior Showmanship winners to determine the best overall showman in each division.

#### SMALL STOCK SHOWMANSHIP

The Show will start at 3:00 p.m., Thursday afternoon in the Coors Event Arena. Check in is between 2:00 and 2:30 p.m. Showing will be in the following order: Peewee, Junior, Senior, and Round Robins will be held at the end of Senior Showmanship. The Danish placing system will be used for all Showmanship classes except Peewee division. The Peewee division is strictly educational, so only participation rosettes will be given and an older brother, sister or adult must assist all Peewee showmen.
