RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. QUALIFICATIONS / CATEGORIES

Animals must have State Inspection papers (hauling permits). Any Arizona Breeder may enter all classes. Junior Livestock exhibitors may enter all lots listed and shall receive ribbons and premiums. Juniors will be required to enter both Open and Junior Livestock. Juniors will not be allowed to show bulls over one year of age.

Exhibitor must own the animal he/she shows, or have a lease agreement from owner to show animal, to receive premium in open classes. Lease agreements need to be dated no earlier than 30 days prior to Fair start.

2. ENTRY FORM(S) / FEES

Entry fees: \$10.00 per entry, Large Livestock Entry Form (AVAILABLE ONLINE AT www.YavapaiDownsAtPV.com) must be mailed to, Beth Tritz, Superintendent, c/o Yavapai County Fair, P.O. Box 26557, Prescott Valley, AZ 86312 no later than Friday, September 17, 2010.

3. ENTRY DATES & PROCEDURES

The Yavapai County Fair reserves the right to limit the entries. Animals must be in place between 10:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m., Wednesday, Sept. 29, 2010 or by 10:00 a.m. Thursday, Sept. 30, 2010. Late entries will be accepted on space availability. Each exhibitor will be entitled to ONE fair entry pass regardless of how many entries the person has.

4. DISPLAY RULES

Care of the animals is the responsibility of the owner. First bedding of shavings will be provided by the YCFA. Additional bedding if needed shall be provided by the exhibitor. A feed store will be available on the grounds for your livestock needs. Feeding and alley/stall cleaning shall be completed by 8:00 a.m. every morning.

5. JUDGING & PREMIUMS / VOUCHERS

Judging for the Junior show will start at 10:00 a.m. Friday, Oct. 2, 2010; judging for the Open show will be on Saturday. ALL JUDGE'S DECISIONS ARE FINAL.

COMMERCIAL BREEDING HEIFERS (Lot CBH)

Limited to Pens of Three (3), Yearling Heifers (all beef breeds, including crossbreeds) born after January 1, 2010. Classes will be judged on quality and conformation. All breeds and crossbreeds will be judged together.

COMMERCIAL STEERS (Lot CS)

Limited to Pens of Three (3), Yearling Heifers (all beef breeds, including crossbreeds) born after January 1, 2010. Classes will be judged on quality and conformation. All breeds and crossbreeds will be judged together.

PEN OF 3 REGISTERED HEIFERS (Lot RH)

(Separate classes for each breed)
1. Pen of Three (3) Yearling Heifers
2. Pen of Three (3) Two-Year-Old Heifers

PEN OF 3 REGISTERED BULLS (Lot RB)

(Separate classes for each breed)
1. Pen of Three (3) Yearling Bulls
2. Pen of Three (3) Two-Year-Old Bulls

HALTER CLASSES

Halter cattle must be broke to lead and show. Unruly animals will be disqualified.

HEIFERS (Lot H) (Specify breed on entry form)

1. Summer Calf 3/1/10 - 7/1/10
2. Early Spring Calf 1/1/10 - 2/28/10
3. Fall Calf 10/1/09 - 12/31/09
4. Junior Yearling 4/1/09 - 9/30/09
5. Senior Yearling 10/1/08 - 3/31/09
6. Two-Year-Old Heifer 12/31/07 - 9/30/08
7. Cows, ages 3 and Up
