RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. QUALIFICATIONS / CATEGORIES

The show is open to dairy cattle of Arizona. Purebred cattle must be registered. Exhibitors need to provide proof of attempt to register crossbred cattle. The YCFA shall reserve the right to limit entries to facilities available and may limit the number of entries without discrimination. In all cases the management reserves the right to reject entirely or accept conditionally any entry or application.

Animals from out of state must have inspection papers (hauling permits). All cattle must be fitted for show. Bulls six months of age and older must have rings in their noses and be shown by persons capable of handling and keeping control of the animals at all times. No bulls over two years of age will be shown by any person under 18 years of age. Older bulls must be tied while in the stall with equipment strong enough to hold them or secured with heavy locks. Junior showmen may not be allowed to show bulls over 1 year of age.

Exhibitor must own the animal he/she shows or have a lease agreement from owner to show the animal to receive awards. Lease agreements need to be dated no earlier than 30 days prior to show date. Exhibitors in the showmanship classes DO NOT need to own the animal, but the exhibitor must do all of the grooming of the animal to receive awards.

Junior Livestock exhibitors of Yavapai County may enter all lots listed including showmanship, and will receive ribbons and premiums in both Open and Junior Livestock. Juniors will be required to enter both Open and Jr. Livestock.

2. ENTRY FORM(S) / FEES

Please fill out Large Livestock Entry Form (AVAILABLE ONLINE AT www.YavapaiDownsAtPV.com) completely! NO DAIRY TO BEEF crossbreds will be accepted. All entries with the fee must be recorded with the Superintendent, left at the Fairgrounds no later than Friday, September 17, 2010. ENTRY FEE: \$10.00 per animal, for open division and \$4.00 for youth division.

3. ENTRY DATES & PROCEDURES

Animals must be in place by 8:00 p.m., Wednesday, September 29, 2010. Late entries will be accepted on space availability. Each exhibitor will be entitled to ONE fair entry pass regardless of how many entries the person has.

4. DISPLAY RULES

Care of the animals is the responsibility of the owner / leasee. First bedding of shaving will be provided by the YCFA. If additional bedding is needed it shall be provided by the exhibitor. Feeding and alley / stall cleaning should be completed by 10:00 a.m. every morning.

5. JUDGING & PREMIUMS / VOUCHERS

Judging will start of 10:00 a.m. Saturday, October 2, 2010. JUDGE'S DECISIONS ARE FINAL. White shirt or blouse and white pants are traditionally worn in the show ring and are recommended for all classes. FFA or 4-H jackets may be worn over whites where appropriate.

No animal shall be removed from its space before 4:30 p.m. on Sun., Oct. 3, 2010, and no later than 6:00 p.m.

SHOWMANSHIP (Must enter in Dept. LL)

Showmanship is limited to youth of Yavapai County who are 19 years of age or younger as the first day of the fair. All exhibitors who reach age 14 on or before the first day of the fair will be classified as Senior Youths, and all exhibitors who remain under age 14 before the first day of the fair will be classified as Junior Youths. Cattle must be broke to lead and show. Unruly animals will be disqualified by the judge.

HERDS AND GROUPS

All animals shown in Lots 20-27 must have shown in single Lots/Classes. Animals to compose a competitive group need not be named for competition unless otherwise specified at the time of entry. Exhibitors for such entries must indicate in which group he/she expects to compete in, and how many entries he/she desire to show in each group at time of making entry. Sire or Dam must be named on entry forms in group/classes where they are required

Lot 20. Calf Herd: Consists of one (1) bull, from lots 1-3, and two (2) heifers, from lots 6-8. Must be owned by exhibitor.

Lot 21. Yearling Herd: Consists of one (1) bull, from Lot 4, and two (2) heifers, lots 9-10. Must be owned by exhibitor.

Lot 22. Junior Get Of Sire: Consists of three (3) animals under 2 years of age, either sex, the get of one (1) sire. Not more than two (2) can be bulls. Sire must be named. Must be owned by exhibitor.

Lot 23. Dairy Herd: Consists of four (4) cows that have freshened. (calved) Must be owned by exhibitor.

Lot 24. Best 3 Females: Consists of three (3) females, any age, all owned by exhibitor. Only one (1) entry per exhibitor.

Lot 25. Senior Get Of Sire: To consist of four (4) animals, either sex, but not more than (1) bull. All sired by the same bull, at least one (1) animal must be 2 years old or older. At least one (1) of the animals must be bred and owned by the exhibitor. Sire must be named. Only one (1) get of sire allowed.

Lot 26. Product of Dam: To consist of two (2) animals, either sex, any age, the product of one (1) Dam. Dam must be named. Exhibitor need not own Dam.

Lot 27. Dam Daughter: To consist of two (2) animals, the Dam and her Daughter. Exhibitor must own Dam.
