ABOUT THE 2010 COVER ARTIST

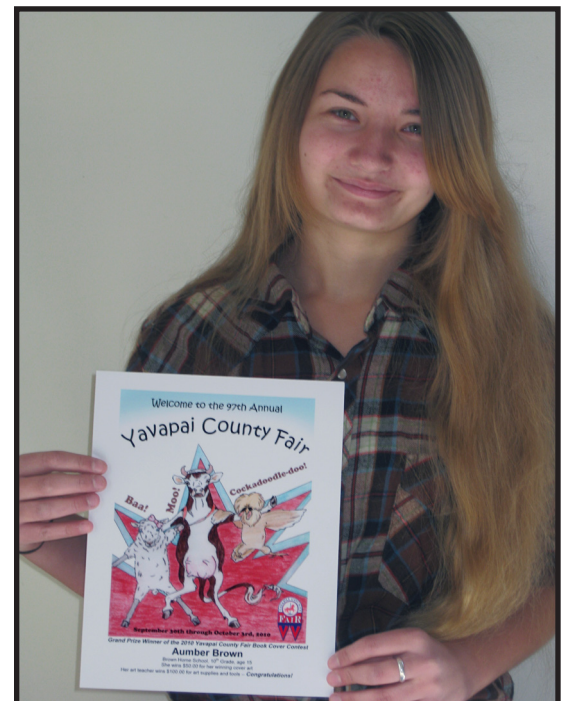
